**Guidelines for completing a notice to
remove, dismantle, demolish or destroy a building
or other structure in a disaster situation form DM9**

General

In accordance with Subsection (1)(h) of the *Disaster Management Act 2003* a relevant District Disaster Coordinator (DDC) or Declared Disaster Officer (DDO) may remove, dismantle, demolish or destroy a vehicle, or a building or other structure, in the declared area.

Section 77(2) provides that a DDO may exercise a power under subsection (1)(h) in relation to a building or other structure only with the written approval of a relevant DDC.

Note 1
