QUEENSLAND STATE DISASTER MANAGEMENT PLAN

Background

The plan was developed by a project team on behalf of the Queensland Disaster Management Committee (QDMC) which was governed by a steering committee chaired by the Commissioner, Queensland Fire and Emergency Services.

The team researched and consulted widely to develop a plan that positions Queensland for the future. The plan is a living document and will change in the coming years. It is a central point of reference for disaster management in Queensland.

New Features

- Roles and Responsibilities highlighted in maroon at the start of relevant sections, with a comprehensive table at Appendix C of the plan.
- Maps—Visual representation of our disaster management groups and committees, disaster districts, referable dams and our disaster management documents.
- Priorities Calendar—Provides guidance concerning disaster management activities in relation to Queensland's Hazard profile.
- **Design**—Spiral bound for ease of use, banded by maroon with highlighting to enhance visibility and each chapter marked by a tabard.
